In the **PET listening exam**, there are <u>4 parts</u>. You might hear <u>monologues</u> (one person speaking) or <u>dialogues</u> (two people having a conversation). The topics will generally be neutral or informal and they will be on a range of everyday topics.






PET (PRELIMINARY ENGLISH TEST)

In this part, you will be given <u>7 short listening texts</u>, and for each one you will have a question with three pictures (A, B or C). You have to listen to each recording and choose the right answer from the 3 choices. Here's an example of such a question:

Example: Where did the man leave his camera?













PET (PRELIMINARY ENGLISH TEST) HOW TO DO PART 1-TIPS

Because the answers will always be visual, this might make it sound easy. However, you will have to pay attention to the details in each small picture.

When deciding the answer, there are certain things you will need to remember or do:

- Always read the question carefully and look at the pictures before you listen.
- Know the answers can be at the start, middle or end of each recording. They might try to trick you by putting what could be the answer at the start, when the key information is at the end.
- You might need to listen for a lot of information, or sometimes only one small detail. If a picture is quite detailed, then you will have to pay extra attention to the details.

Man: Oh no, I haven't got my camera!

Woman: But you used it just now to take a photograph of the **fountain**.

Man: Oh! I remember. I put it down on the steps

while I put my <u>coat on</u>.


Woman: Well, let's try back quickly, it might still be there.


You can see from this answer that she mentions all three: <u>Fountain</u>, <u>a coat and the steps</u>. However, the answer is clearly the t-shirt. They will nearly always mention something about all the pictures, so you will have to pay special attention to what's being said.



PET (PRELIMINARY ENGLISH TEST) LISTENING PART 2-TIPS

This part has <u>6 multiple-choice questions</u>, but you will hear <u>1 long</u> monologue or 1 interview here. You have to listen to the recording and choose the right answer **A**, **B** or **C**. You will need to listen to identify specific information and detailed meaning. Here is an example:

PET (PRELIMINARY ENGLISH TEST) LISTENING PART 2-TIPS

When deciding the answer, there are certain things you will need to remember or do:

- The questions will often use different words from the recording, so think about synonyms and paraphrasing.
- If you don't hear the answer to one question, don't worry about it.

 Keep focused or you could miss the answer to the next. Remember you always get 2 chances to listen to the recording.
- ▶ Before the recording starts, you get some time to read through the instructions and questions, you should use this to help you focus on and understand what you are likely to hear.

Woman: Tonight I'm delighted to welcome the writer Peter Taylor

Peter: Good evening.

Woman: Peter, your books are all set in different countries, aren't they?

Peter: Yes, well... I was born in South Africa and I still live there. Everything in my novels

happen in countries I know. <u>I began writing a novel about a family living in Kenya</u>. I spent a couple of years there <u>when I was growing up</u>. <u>My most recent</u>

book was about Morocco. I spent several months there last year.

Woman: I see. So when did you first visit England?

As you can see, the recording uses language that appears in all three answers. However, you have to pay attention and listen for the correct one. The answer will nearly always be paraphrased so make sure you are prepared for that.
